- To understand the importance of preferences and that everyone is different

Learning intention

- I will learn about the skills and qualities of myself and my classmates

Success criteria

- I can identify the skills and qualities that I and those around me have
- I can demonstrate that I value others contributions through listening actively and responding appropriately

This activity is suitable for Second level and can be used to enhance learning at the start of each year group i.e. P5, P6, P7

Suggested activities

- Mindmap the skills and qualities young people think their teacher/any teacher should have
- Discuss how a teacher learns new skills needed for their job e.g. in-service days
- Divide young people into small working groups (three-four per group)
- Issue each young person with Skills and qualities 1 which should be used as an example of some of the skills and qualities someone might have
- The group should collate feedback for each team member on their skills and qualities using post it notes. Agreement must be reached within the group
- Everyone to record their agreed skills and qualities using Skills and qualities 2 and where possible expand upon these and give examples
- Discussion of recorded skills and qualities and their relevance in the workplace

Next steps and related activities

- Pupils can go to myworldofwork.co.uk/ican and use Skills builder to record what skills they have used taking part in this activity
- Young people to demonstrate an identified skill/quality to others in a Celebration of success ceremony to which parents could be invited
- Consider completing Same but different activity next
